1.0 GENERAL RULES

1.1 Club competitions

The London Golf Club is responsible for the smooth operation, promotion, playing & organisation of all club members' competitions.

The competition charter is designed to be one of the sources of information for the members & management team, acting as a source of reference for questions relating to members' competitions. This document will be amended & extended, as required.

Competitors must have a registered Handicap Index through MyEG. Competitors may have additional rules, which are set out within this charter under 3.0 DETAILED COMPETITION SHEETS.

All competitions will be uploaded on Golf Genius from 1st January 2026, and all members are responsible for signing up for each competition using the Golf Genius application. Each competition will contain all the required details about the competition, e.g. name, handicap limit, eligibility, entry fee & closing date.

Members playing in any competition must register & pay the relevant entry fee at the registration desk at least 20 minutes before their tee time. The Membership Executive and/or starter may ask competitors to move up or down a tee time for the event to run more efficiently.

When playing on a non-membership subscription day, 5-day members must pay the relevant member-guest green fee to the Golf Shop.

1.2 Eligibility - board competitions

Members must have submitted a minimum of 10 scorecards (including 3 competition scorecards), played at The London Golf Club on MyEnglandGolf from 1st April 2025 up to the competition date.

Members who play at county and country level events must submit a minimum of 5 competition cards played at The London Golf Club to qualify for eligibility into the Order of Merit. The Handicap Committee will review players who are in this category.

Members who have not adhered to the above obligations within the date range will need to submit the required number of scorecards to be able to win a board competition.

Members who are not eligible to win a board competition can still enter to complete their required number of scorecards. The entry fee will not be charged.

The 2's competition can still be paid for and entered for each event. If no members win a 2, then the entry fund will be donated to the golf club's charity of the year.

1.3 Eligibility – knockout competitions

Members must have submitted a minimum of 10 scorecards (including 3 competition scorecards) on MyEnglandGolf from 1st April 2025 – 1st April 2026.

1.4 Entry requirements – board competitions

Members must enter each competition via Golf Genius or email the Membership Executive at member@londongolf.co.uk.

Each draw for a board competition will be completed randomly, and members are not permitted to request a preferred tee time.

Members must enter before 10:00 on the Friday, before the competition date. Any members who enter after 10:00 on the Friday, will be allocated a tee time to suit the best needs of the start sheet.

The provisional draw will be made on the Friday before 10:30.

It is the members' responsibility to organise any changes directly with other competing members, and communicate the necessary changes via email, to the Membership Executive on the Friday before 16:00.

Members can withdraw from the competition on the Friday before 16:00, and this must be communicated via email to the Membership Executive.

The final draw will be made and sent on Friday at 16:00.

5-day members, country members & junior members can enter competitions; however, they are unable to win the event or obtain order of merit points. The relevant green fee must be paid in the Golf Shop before the competition.

1.5 Scoring & competition results

Under Rule 3.3b (Rules of Golf), it is the player and their designated marker who bear responsibility for recording their scores.

The scores can be recorded on a physical card or by electronic means at the discretion of London Golf Club management.

It is preferable, wherever possible, that the entry of competition scores should be by electronic means. This is enabled by the use of Golf Genius which provides an easy to use mobile application.

Players should sign into Golf Genius using the GGID provided by the Membership Executive & agree who will be the designated marker before the round commences.

It is strongly recommended that a physical scorecard is also completed and cross-checked after the round.

Competition results will be finalised and published through Golf Genius on the same day of the competition. Midweek & weekend roll-ups results will be finalised & published the following day.

1.6 Handicap allowances

Handicap allowances are designed to provide equity for players of all levels of ability in each format of competition play. They are applied to the course handicap to calculate a player's playing handicap for the competition. The London Golf Club will manage this process through Golf Genius, using members' WHS handicap before the competition starts.

Members must have a valid MyEnglandGolf handicap to participate in competitions. If the London Golf Club is not the members' home club, members can become secondary members or transfer home clubs. This can be requested through the Membership Executive.

A handicap review will be completed by the handicap committee on the last day of every month, through England Golf. Any discrepancies that are flagged will be reviewed, amended & communicated directly to the member via the Membership Executive.

The handicap committee will conduct all monthly reviews and act accordingly, in conjunction with England Golf recommendations. The report reviews are as follows:

- General play scores review
- Handicap review report
- Exceptional scores report
- Competitions vs. general play report
- Deleted scores report
- Last played report

1.7 Prizes

ORDER OF MERIT COMPETITIONS

Prizes are awarded to the top 3 winners of Order of Merit competitions and will be credited to the members' levy card, up to 7 days after the competition has closed.

The prize fund for each event will generally be 50% of the net proceeds of the entry fees after costs for food & beverage, and the Order of Merit has been allocated.

The top 3 winners of each competition will then receive the following breakdown:

MONTHLY MEDAL & STABLEFORD COMPETITIONS

For midweek & weekend competitions, prizes are awarded to the top 3 winners and will be credited to the members' levy card, up to 7 days after the competition has closed.

The prize fund will be 100% of the entry fees.

The top 3 winners of each competition will then receive the following breakdown:

2'S COMPETITIONS

There will be a 2's prize fund for each board & non-board competition, which any member can enter.

The total 2's prize fund will be accumulated and split equally across members who obtain a 2 during a competition.

If no members win a 2, then the entry fund will be donated to the golf club's charity of the year.

1.7 Prizes (*extended*)

ORDER OF MERIT

The Order of Merit prize fund is accumulated from the 9 x Order of Merit competitions throughout the season.

The prize fund is generally 50% of the total entry fee from each competition.

Prizes will be credited to the members' levy card, up to 7 days after the competition has closed.

The top 5 winners of the Order of Merit will then receive the following breakdown:

The London Golf Club management team will also source a title sponsor, who will support the winner with an individual prize.

1.8 No-show policy

The final competition start sheet will be confirmed & sent to members at 1600, the Friday before the competition starts. Once the competition has been confirmed, any late withdrawals must be emailed to the Membership Executive with a valid reason as to why they cannot play.

Members who have a valid, exceptional circumstance will be permitted to enter the next competition. Members who are unable to provide a valid reason will be suspended from the next competition. This will be communicated via email by the Membership Executive.

1.9 Use of buggies in competitions

Players & caddies (caddies are permitted to be used in all competitions) must always walk, unless permission to use a buggy has been given by the London Golf Club management team, prior to the competition date. The London Golf Club management team shall maintain a list of all current exemptions.

The following describes eligibility for consideration:

Members with permanent disabilities/conditions may, with the permission of the London Golf Club management team, use buggies for competition rounds, when playing conditions allow.

1.9 Use of buggies in competitions *(extended)*

Members with temporary disabilities/conditions may approach the London Golf Club management team with the appropriate medical certificate for permission to use buggies.

If permission is given, it will be set for a period of time and will need to be revalidated after that time has elapsed.

Playing partners of members with permission to use a buggy, may not use the buggy for equipment, nor may they ride as passengers. Members will be disqualified from the competition should they not adhere to this.

1.9(a) Use of buggies in 36-hole competitions

Members competing in 36-hole competitions on the same day, can use a buggy for the 2nd round at no charge. These competitions include the Jack Nicklaus Trophy & Club Championship.

1.10 Junior members

Juniors are defined as members of the London Golf Club who are under 18 years of age on 1st April in the current year.

ORDER OF MERIT COMPETITIONS

To gain competition experience & for handicap purposes, juniors are permitted to play in Order of Merit competitions but are not eligible to win. Juniors will not receive Order of Merit points.

SINGLES & DOUBLES KNOCKOUT

Juniors are not eligible to compete in these competitions.

MONTHLY MEDAL & STABLEFORD COMPETITIONS

To gain competition experience & for handicap purposes, juniors are permitted to play in monthly medal & stableford competitions but are not eligible to win.

When playing in club competitions, juniors cannot play as a 2-ball, and if playing as a 3-ball, only 1 member can be a junior.

1.10 Junior members *(extended)*

Juniors are eligible to play & win the following competitions:

- Jade Tee Challenge
- Members Appreciation Day (Only 1 junior per adult member team)
- London Golf Club Pro-Am (Only 1 junior per adult member team)
- Black Tee Challenge
- Members' Guest Day (Only 1 junior per adult member team)
- Construction Cup (Only 1 junior per adult member team)
- Turkey Trot

1.11 Member category eligibility

The table below highlights what competitions members can enter & win throughout the year.

Lady members can compete and win in all competitions. Lady members will be required to play from the Jade tee.

When playing on a non-membership subscription day, the 5-day member must pay the relevant member-guest green fee to the Golf Shop.

Country members MUST use a subscription round from their annual allowance when playing in a club competition. Country members are not permitted to enter a competition when their annual allowance has been used.

Corporate members are permitted to name 2 extensions to obtain an official handicap, play & win in club competitions.



2.0 COMPETITION OVERVIEW

2.1 Order of Merit

The Order of Merit will be a points-based league with each event breakdown as follows:

- 1st Place 10 points
- 2nd Place 9 points
- 3rd Place 8 points
- 4th place 7 points
- 5th Place 6 points
- 6th Place 5 points
- 7th Place 4 points
- 8th Place 3 points
- 9th Place 2 points
- 10th place 1 point

The 9 x Order of Merit qualifying competitions are:

- International Trophy
- Spring Trophy
- Jack Nicklaus Trophy (36 holes)
- Captain's Cup
- Chairman's Trophy
- Club Championship (Net)* (36 holes)**
- Presidents Cup
- Founder's Trophy
- Autumn Cup

*The Net Club Championship results will qualify for the Order of Merit.

**The Club Championship winner (board competition) will be determined on the gross score.

In the result of a tie in the final Order of Merit standings, the winner will be decided on the number of competition wins. If again, this is equal, the winner will be the member who had the best score in the final event of the Order of Merit, the Autumn Cup.

Members who are not eligible to win a board competition will not have their scorecards submitted to the Order of Merit. The scorecard will be uploaded into MyEnglandGolf, as a competition card for handicap & eligibility purposes.



2.0 COMPETITION OVERVIEW

2.2 Board competitions

There are certain requirements players MUST complete both prior to & at the end of the competition.

The requirements are:

CHECK IN

Prior to starting the round, the player MUST report to the competition desk. Competition rules & conditions, tees used, pin sheets, local rules & other information will be advised. Members MUST pay their entry fee prior to the competition starting. Members MUST check in at least 20 minutes before their tee time.

SIGN IN

Appoint 1 x member to operate the Golf Genius application.

SCORE ENTRY

At the completion of the round, members are required to enter scores on Golf Genius.

2.3 Monthly medal & stableford competitions

Members can 'roll-up' and enter in the Golf Shop, for monthly medal & stableford competitions.

Entry for each competition is £5, with an optional 2's competition for £5. The entry fee is only required for members who are eligible to win the competition, based on the club's eligibility requirements.

Players are required to book their own tee time through EliteLive and groups must be 2 members or more. Scorecards must be signed by another member and returned to the Golf Shop upon completion of the round. If scorecards are not returned, then the member will be disqualified from the competition and the entry fee will be kept for awarding the prizes.

Each monthly medal & stableford competition requires a minimum of 5 members to participate for the competition to qualify. If there are fewer than 5 members competing, the competition will be cancelled, and the entry fees returned to the member.

The results will be closed & posted the following day, and members will receive the prizes on their levy card, up to 7 days after the competition has closed.



2.0 COMPETITION OVERVIEW

2.4 Knockout competitions

- Members may sign-up for participation in knockout competitions, subject to having a registered handicap index and the required eligibility status.
- The dates by which the various rounds of the match play competition must be played, will be displayed on the draw sheet, on Golf Genius. If a single member of a pair has to withdraw prior to their 1st match, a new partner may be added with the permission of the London Golf Club management team. Once the 1st round has been played, no substitutions will be allowed.
- The knockout draw will be made on 1st April 2026, with a 3-week deadline for each round to be played.
- The top pairing must submit via writing to their opponents, a minimum of 3 varied dates (at least 1 x midweek & 1 x weekend date must be offered) for the round to be played. These dates must be communicated within 1 week of the round commencing.
- If these dates are not submitted to the opponent, then the bottom pairing will receive a bye to the next round. If the dates submitted by the top pairing cannot be played by the bottom pairing within the deadline, then the top pairing will be awarded a bye to commence to the next round.
- The dates submitted by the top pairing must also be submitted to the Membership Executive at member@londongolf.co.uk
- Entry & pre-payment for knockouts must be submitted via Golf Genius by the 15th March 2026.
- Members must submit the outcome via the Membership Executive, who will manually input the results onto Golf Genius.
- Each Singles and Pairs match must be played off the White tees.
- All adult members can register for the singles and pairs matchplay, however if matches are played on the weekend the relevant green fee must be paid.
- Country members must use their rounds allocation when playing a match.
